Gulfstream is about to launch the newest initiative in its comprehensive Partners 2 Health (P2H) program for employees. Under the partnership, the company provides resources like quality medical plans and health-related information, and Gulfstream families use that information to make informed decisions about their health care.

Now Gulfstream is partnering with Ourlife to make improvements to our health-care plan that could produce short-term and long-term health benefits while generating a significant savings in the cost of medications for you, your family and the company. Founded in 2006 by Dr. Paul Bradley and 40 prominent Savannah physicians, Ourlife focuses on health and wellness programs that optimize the quality of life while reducing health-care expenses.

Having eliminated the patient co-payment on many generic prescription drugs, we're now introducing S.A.V.E. Rx (Script Analysis Value Enhancement) to employees. It is our goal to introduce the program to dependents at a later date. Developed by the doctors at Ourlife, S.A.V.E. Rx simplifies the challenging task of identifying the lowest-cost medications covered under our insurance plan – in other words, offering "the best medicine at the best price."

With S.A.V.E. Rx, you will receive a report which lists your current medications and a list of similar, high-quality, alternative medications that are less expensive. Neither Gulfstream nor S.A.V.E. Rx will tell you what drug to take. Only you and your doctor can determine the medicine that's best for you.

The S.A.V.E. Rx report presents information about medication costs, any associated co-payments, and possible alternatives that will be equally effective, but will produce a cost savings. You will have the opportunity to review the medication report in a personal consultation with an Ourlife nurse practitioner at Gulfstream. You and your doctor can then discuss the alternative medications and select the proper medication for you. Doctors tell us that they find this new service helpful in their efforts to provide the best care for their patients.

**To protect your confidentiality, S.A.V.E. Rx/Ourlife will not provide Gulfstream with any personal medication information about you. Only you and your physician will receive a copy of your personal report.**

There is no pressure on you to change your medication. This is a completely voluntary program. Even if you do not take medication or are not enrolled in our health care plan, you will still receive a packet of information from Ourlife with ideas that may save you money and improve your quality of life.

Gulfstream will pay all costs associated with the program. We know that the cost to take care of yourself can be a financial burden – especially during these challenging times.
